“Advocacy, Court Room Etiquette and Ethics: from the perspective of a former Practitioner – Retired Judge”

About the Speaker

Dato' Varghese George graduated with an LLB degree from the University of Singapore in 1974, and was in private legal practice for 35 years, principally involved in civil litigation in various types of commercial cases, construction-related suits and arbitration, land matters, and administrative law disputes. He was the Senior Partner at Messrs Zain & Co before being appointed as a Judicial Commissioner in October 2009. He was elevated as Judge of the High Court in August 2011, and as a Judge of the Court of Appeal in September 2013. He retired from the Bench at the end of January 2017.

He is a Fellow of both the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators and the Malaysian Institute of Arbitrators. He is presently on the Panel of Mediators, Adjudicators and Arbitrators of the Kuala Lumpur Centre for Arbitration (“KLRCA”).
